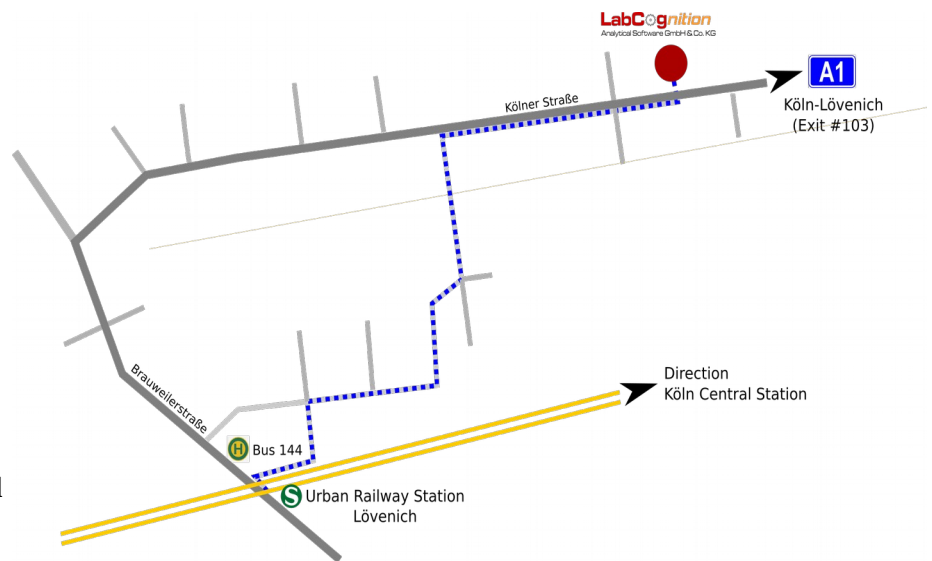

NOTE: Push the entrance door hard to open it. It is never locked during office hours!



Travelling by airplane (international guests)

The airport **Köln/Bonn** (Cologne/Bonn; airport signature: **CGN**) is an international airport located closest to the office. You may take public transport to reach Cologne central station within approx. 20 min. The next closest international airport is **Frankfurt am Main** (airport signature: **FRA**). A high speed (named ICE) train takes you to Cologne central train station or Cologne Trade Fair Deutz station in approx. 1 hour. Such trains depart from “Frankfurt am Main Fernbahnhof” approx. every 20 minutes. From both stations (Cologne Central station and Cologne Trade Fair Deutz) several direct connections to the station **Lövenich** being next to our office are available.

Rental car stations are available on both airports. However, depending on traffic travelling by car very often takes longer than travelling by public transport (From Cologne/.Bonn airport to the office it might take approx. 1 hour; From Frankfurt am Main airport it takes approx. 2 hours).

Travelling with public transport

Arriving at Cologne Central Train Station “**Hauptbahnhof**” (abbrev.: “Köln HBF”) or Train Station “**Köln Messe/Deutz**” (Cologne Trade Fair Deutz) you have to take the urban railway to get to the station „**Lövenich**“. (Note: Urban railway stations are marked with a white “S” on green background).

It takes another 10 minutes walk or a 4 minutes bus ride from the urban railway station to the office (see below).

Urban railway trains or regional trains depart from Cologne central station or Cologne Trade Fair Deutz station approx. every 20 minutes:

1. Take urban railway train **S19** with direction “Sindorf” or „Düren“. Alternatively you may take **S12** with direction “Horrem“. Both trains are departing from both, station „Hauptbahnhof“ and „Köln Messe/Deutz“!

Note: In most trains and metro lines announcements are made before reaching the next station. In addition most trains are equipped with televisions indicating the name of the next stop.

2. Exit the train station “**Lövenich**” and follow “**Brauweilerstraße**” with direction North-West.

Proceed by Bus:

You will find a bus stop after approx. 40m. Take the **bus number 144** with direction “**Junkersdorf**”. Exit the bus at the 2nd stop at “**Dieselstraße**”. The office building is directly on the other side of the street.

Pedestrians:

Alternatively, you may have a nice walk of about 1 km. Approx. 25m after exiting the train station “Lövenich” turn right into the street “**Odemshofallee**”. Follow the street for approx. 150m. Then turn right into “**Vinzenzallee**”. After approx 170m turn left into “**Fuchsweg**”. After approx. 150m keep left to follow Fuchsweg for another 200m until you reach “**Kölner Straße**”. Turn right and follow Kölner Straße for another 300m. The office building is to your left on the other side of the street.

Travelling by car

Coming from “Ludwigshafen” in the **South** take highway **A61**. Close to Cologne this highway automatically becomes **A1**. Follow the highway **A1** until you reach exit „**Köln-Lövenich**“ (No. 103). See below to continue.

Coming from “Frankfurt am Main” in the **South** take highway **A3** with direction “Oberhausen”. Follow the highway **A3** until you reach junction „**Autobahndreieck Köln-Heumar**“ (No. 28). Follow the **A4** with direction “**Aachen**“ until you reach junction “**Autobahnkreuz Köln-West**“ (No. 10). Here you must change to **A1** with direction „**Leverkusen, Dortmund, Bremen**“. See below to continue.

Coming from “Dortmund, Bremen, Hannover” in the **North** take highway **A1**. Follow the highway **A1** until you reach junction until you reach exit „**Köln-Lövenich**“ (No. 103). See below to continue.

Coming from “Hannover, Oberhausen” in the **East** take highway **A2**. This highway automatically becomes the highway **A3** in “Oberhausen“. Follow the highway **A3** with direction “Köln, Frankfurt“ until you reach junction „**Autobahnkreuz Leverkusen**“ (No. 23). Change here to highway **A1** with direction “Köln, Koblenz“ and follow the highway **A1** until you reach exit „**Köln-Lövenich**“ (No. 103). See below to continue.

Coming from “Aachen” in the **West** take highway **A4** until you reach junction „**Autobahnkreuz Köln-West**“, (Nr. 10). Here you must change to **A1** with direction „**Leverkusen, Dortmund, Bremen**“. See below to continue.

Coming from “Olpe” in the **East** take highway **A4** until you reach junction **Autobahnkreuz Köln-West** (No. 10). Here you must change to **A1** with direction „**Leverkusen, Dortmund, Bremen**“. See below to continue.

Coming from one of the above directions, take the Exit „**Köln-Lövenich**“ (No. 103) with direction „**Köln-Müngersdorf**“. Take the left lane, since you must directly turn left again at the traffic lights into „**Vogelsanger Weg**“. This street becomes the „**Engelspfad**“ then. Move on until you can only turn left or right. Here turn left to enter „**Kölner Straße**“. Cross the bridge and the office will appear on the right side after approx. 650m.

Office location

The office is located directly at the bus stop “Dieselstraße”. Feel free to park your car on one of the visitors’ parking lots showing the sign “**Besucher**” on the floor.
